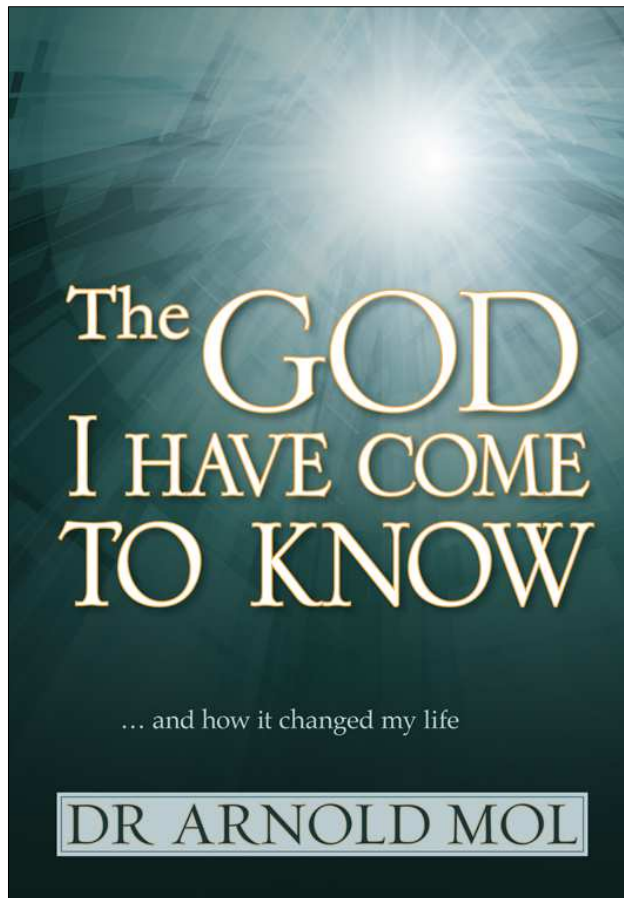


The God I Have Come to Know
